

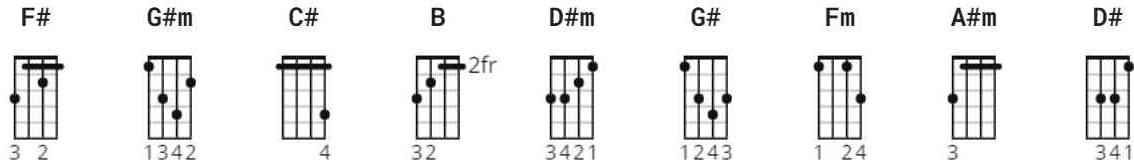
Paint Me A Birmingham Chords by Tracy Lawrence
